1. Title

Specially Appointed Associate Professor (non-tenured, four-year contract)

2. Research Field

Post-Soviet politics with a focus on Russia

3. Qualifications

1. The applicant must hold a PhD degree.
2. The applicant must have a near-native level of English and Russian proficiency to conduct research, take classes, and participate in administrative activities.
3. After employment, the applicant must acquire basic knowledge of the Japanese language, sufficient for administrative communication.

4. Job Description

1. The applicant will strive to achieve outstanding results in the above-mentioned research field.
2. The applicant will contribute to the joint usage/research activities of the Slavic-Eurasian Research Center, including the promotion of interdisciplinary and international research collaborations.
3. The applicant will teach courses and advise students and junior researchers.
4. The applicant will contribute to the Center's publishing and public relations activities.
5. The applicant will participate in other activities of the Center.
