Trickster in Soviet Culture A Cynical Challenge

Lipovetsky explores how the representation of tricksters in Soviet culture has facilitated counter-narratives of modernity that developed in the shadow of the “official” Soviet project. The trickster, exemplified by Ostap Bender, Benya Krik, Ivan Babichev, Khulio Khurenito and other beloved characters, simultaneously manifest Soviet cynicism as the strategy of survival and mock cynicism of power. Trickster narratives provide models for subjectivation that, although marginalized and censured within official Soviet sociocultural contexts, competed with normative and authoritative discourses of Soviet subjectivity for prevalence in society at large. At the same time, because the trickster figure aestheticizes and idealizes cynicism, it reveals the limits and dangers of cynical strategies.
